Our ambitious plan has two main objectives. Firstly, to expand and enhance our already impressive club facilities, and secondly, to accommodate the ever-increasing number of boys, girls, young men, and women from the Mullingar area who are taking part in football within the community.

This 'Facilities Development Plan' completes one important pillar within our overall "Club Strategic Plan 2023-30". This document provides an illustrative overview and detailed breakdown of the planned infrastructure which will be constructed over four phases along with an estimate of costs. We commenced with Phase 1 in March 2023 and our aim is to complete all phases with the help of our club members, external stakeholders and the wider community.

We are excited about the future of our club and would like to invite you to join us on this journey..

CLUB HISTORY 1983 - 2023

Mullingar Athletic AFC was founded in 1983 with a single Senior Men's team, competing in the Leinster football league.

The club eventually increased its senior men's teams to three by 1990, and in 1992 it established its first underage schoolboy's team. The club formed its first senior women's team in 2004.

The club's facilities at Gainstown have been developed extensively, with a total investment exceeding €3.5 Million. The initial purchase of 10 acres in 1992 from Westmeath County Council enabled the club to develop two grass pitches and a clubhouse.

In the following years, the club purchased an additional 8 acres, which has been used to develop another grass pitch and a full-size floodlit 3G All-Weather pitch. Since then, the club has purchased an additional 4 acres, which will be used to create a 4G Floodlit All-Weather Pitch as part of Phase 2 of the Facilities Development Plan.


This investment has led to the establishment of one of the finest sports facilities in the Mullingar area, as well as the wider Midlands Region.













OUR CURRENT FACILITIES INCLUDE:

OUR CLUB TODAY

As we celebrate our 40th anniversary in 2023, our club has become one of the most significant community-based sports clubs in Mullingar and the wider Midlands Region.

In addition to our combined club membership of 725, we also provide our top-class football facilities to other users from a variety of community and external stakeholder groups and organisations. These include local and regional schools, regional football leagues for boys and girls, youths and adults.

On a national level, our facilities are used by the 'Football Association of Ireland" (FAI) for player and coaching development, Summer camps, and playing of SFAI National Finals and many other programmes.



Growing membership each year has allowed the club to provide the opportunity to facilitate the inclusion of many new players to become involved in playing team football




BREAKDOWN OF PLAYERS AND MEMBERS IN EACH SECTION OF THE CLUB

The pages that follow explain our phased 2023-2030 Facilities development plan, which began with Phase 1 in March 2023 and will continue with succeeding phases until 2030.


The completion of this plan will provide our Club and the Mullingar Community with a fabulous Football Complex that will enhance the experience of our members and external users well into the future














PHASE 1 Commencement Date March 2023


New Artificial Surface All -Weather Pitch (7-Aside) to be constructed on current sand-based training area.

Full Macadam Surfacing and lining of the main club car park immediately to the front of the club house.

New Fencing and Hedge Planting to road boundary along road frontage.

Construction of new player dugouts on Pitch 2, Pitch 3, and full-size 3G all Weather pitch.






PHASE 2 Provisional Commencement Date 2025

Development of new full-size 4G Artificial Grass All Weather Pitch-(Complete with Floodlights). This will be constructed on the North West side of the site alongside our Existing 3G Full-Size All-Weather Pitch on lands recently purchased from Westmeath County Council.

Extension, surfacing, and lining of the existing overflow car park on South East side of site.







PHASE 3 Provisional Commencement Date 2026-2027

Extension of current club house building to incorporate four additional dressing rooms, Gym area, kit rooms and club merchandising shop.

Construction of Skills Ball Wall.







PHASE 4 Provisional Commencement Date 2028-2030



Construction of spectator stand overlooking main grass pitch.



Construction of Exercise Walkway to link with existing walkway at primary school adjacent to club grounds.



MEMBERS BOND SCHEME

WHAT IS A BOND SCHEME?

The Bond is a repayable loan to Mullingar Athletic AFC. This loan will be repaid interest free to the bond holder over a ten-year period. There will be a legal and binding agreement signed by the club and each individual bond holder. The minimum bond will have a cost of €5,000 and will be repaid at €500 per year for ten years from issue of the bond.


